

PASTOR'S TOOLKIT

No one-size-fits-all solution exists for church revitalization and replanting. Every church and her context is unique. Yet, one component remains essential in every effort: spiritual renewal. Facilities, leadership, ministry, and a host of other issues may need to be addressed, but apart from a move of the Holy Spirit to renew the people of God through the power of the Gospel, we have no hope. Every church seeking to resound in fresh ways for God's glory and the good of their communities must begin by relying on the Lord to renew them spiritually and provide clarity for their future direction.

Six-Week Sermon Series Plan

The following series follows the timeline of the 40 day guide.

- 6. The Pursuit of Renewal 2 Chronicles 7:14

Twelve-Week Sermon Series Plan

The following series focuses on each aspect of the healthy church target to give more time to process the target as well as to intentionally pursue renewal. The 40 Day Guide could function as a part of an overall plan to pursue renewal during the series.

- 8. The Target of Renewal -- Foundations: Prayer
 - Acts 2:42-47 & 4:23-31
- 9. The Target of Renewal -- Structures: Leadership
 - 1 Peter 5:1-5
- 10. The Target of Renewal -- Structures: Membership
 - 1 Corinthians 12:12-26
- 11. The Target of Renewal Structures: Discipleship
 - 2 Timothy 2:1-7
- 12. The Pursuit of Renewal
 - 2 Chronicles 7:14

Small Group Study: Flickering Lamps by Henry Blackaby

Blackaby provides a great resource that provides hope and purpose for struggling churches. The book and video series are setup well for a six-week small group study.

Option 1: *Flickering Lamps* can serve as a great precursor to your renewal focus if you choose the six-week sermon series to coincide with the 40 Day Devotional Guide.

Option 2: If you choose the twelve-week sermon series, *Flickering Lamps* can serve as a community study that precedes or follows the use of the 40 Day Renewal Guide since both require six weeks.
